LGA Climate Change Commission

- Established to:
 - Critically challenge Local Government action on climate change
 - Make recommendations on how the local government response could be improved
- Reported December 2007 - planning to meet again to review progress against recommendations

- New performance management framework a critical opportunity to set climate change targets
- Community leadership + resources = action

CAPACITY

- Harness community capacity
- Address any skill gaps that constrain local action
- Assess resilience of infrastructure to climate change

TRANSPARENCY

- Adopt climate change targets
- Challenge performance, internally and externally
- Move beyond declarations to practical action

ENGAGEMENT

- Play to strengths – a trusted intermediary
- Promote environmental justice
- Use purchasing powers effectively
- Work with key partners

The opportunity ...

- Energy companies will be investing around £4 billion in cutting carbon emissions from the nation's homes over the next three years
- Renewable energy targets will see tens of billions invested in the UK by 2020
- Significant investment in decarbonising Britain's buildings – all new homes to be zero carbon by 2016
